STABLING: Limited stabling is available. Overnight and day pens available. For overnight boarding: it is \$40 per night. \$70 is your board 2 nights. Day Pens are \$15 per day. Water and shade will be provided. Hay, other feeds and bedding is not included, owner/trainer/rider will provide. Pens must be cleaned out before leaving.

HORSES may be dropped off on the Friday before the show between 1:00pm and 5:00pm. Horses may stay until Monday after the show by 12:00pm.

Competitors may bring horses the Friday or Saturday before the show to acclimate and get their horses familiar with our arenas. Make appointment with Marla (808) 385-6265.

FOOTING: Kahalawai small arena (80' x 140') and large arena (75' x 200') are sand. Small arena will be used for warm up and group 1 jumper classes. Small Dressage arena size is 20m x 40m. Standard Dressage arena is 20m x 60m.

1. Divisions:

1. Child (CH) - 12 years old and under on Show Date
2. Junior (JR) - 13 to 17 years old on Show Date
3. Adult Amateur (AA) - 18 years old or more on Show Date
4. Open - Professional Riders/Trainers

2. SHOW AWARDS: Ribbons to sixth place. Overall High point awards for the show will be given. Special Young Rider Awards.

3. SCHEDULE: Riders will be notified of scheduled ride times by phone or email.

5. Show Attire:

Show shirt, Polo Shirt, or Show jackets are optional. Light or white breeches. Tall boots or paddock boots and half chaps same color. Regulation helmet required at all time while mounted. Hair neatly pulled back or well groomed.

6. Test Offered:

A Horse may show up to 4 tests intro and training; up to 2 test for First level and above.

Traditional Dressage: All Tests Level Intro thru 4th.

Date and Time of the closing of entries: 3-25-2022 (early entry discount available when paid and submitted by 3-18-2022; post entries are allowed up until show day before start of first class - late fee is \$5.00 per class).

General Rules:

1. Tie Breakers:

There will be a timed jump off for ties at first place only. Rider with the least fault and fastest time will win the class. All other ties will be decided on fastest time.

2. Jumper Groups:

Group 1:	Group 2:	Group 3:	Group 4:
Ground	(up to 2'0")	(up to 2'6")	(up to 3'0")

3. Ground Poles, Trot Poles, and Cross-Bars:

Scoring will be based on (50%) technical faults (disobedience, off course). Riders are allowed a maximum of 3 faults with elimination when 3rd fault occurs and Horsemanship Score (50%), which will be scored subjectively by the Judge based on how the course was ridden. For example, how straight rider approached poles, their position, or how the rider handled the horse.

4. Gambler's Choice:

Each obstacle carries 10 to 120 points according to difficulty. No combination obstacles. Obstacles must be built so they can be jumped in both directions. Horse and Rider will have sixty (60) seconds to jump all the obstacles in any order and any direction they wish. Time will start when they cross the start line. Start line may be crossed in either direction. The Judge will signal when time is up. The horse and rider must then cross the finish line (in either direction) to end their time. If the fixed time is reached at the moment the horse is ready to take off, the obstacle counts if jumped correctly. Riders/Horses must cross the Start and finish line for scores to count. Each obstacle may be jumped ONLY TWICE. If jumped a THIRD time, points do not count. If a rider falls, they must stop, but is still placed according to the number of points awarded. If a jump is knocked down, the points do not count and the jump may not be jumped again. The Joker Fence is worth 200 pts. If it is knocked down, 200 points are deducted. The winner is the competitor with the most points. Points for Gamblers choice will apply per division for year end. It will be placed as one open division on show day.

5. Jumper Classes:

Jumper Classes will not be timed. Each rider has an optimum time to ride the course. Only riders with a clean round with no faults will be participate in a timed Jump off on a modified course.

FAULTS:

4 FAULTS: Drop Rails

3 FAULTS: Refusal, elimination after 3rd refusal

OFF COURSE : Elimination

1 FAULT: front touch,

1/2 FAULT: hind touch

6. Kahalawai Medal Classes:

The Kahalawai Medal Class, an equitation & horsemanship class ridden over a jumper course, after which time the top 4 competitors return to ride on the flat and the judge then has the option to ask for riders to execute further tests at Judge's discretion.

7. A horse may be entered in up to 3 jump classes at the same height for classes 2'0" and up. May not enter multiple heights. Group 1 Classes may enter up to 4 times.

8. Divisions:

1. Child (CH) - 12 years old and under on Show Date
2. Junior (JR) - 13 to 17 years old on Show Date
3. Adult Amateur (AA) - 18 years old or more on Show Date
4. Open - Professional Riders/Trainers

9. Show Attire:

Show shirt, Polo shirt, or show jacket. Light or white breeches. Tall boots or paddock boots and half chaps same color. Regulation helmet required at all time while mounted. Hair neatly pulled back or well groomed.
