High Point Award by Division:

Dressage Day

- Combine score 2 different tests (Traditional Dressage) with same horse and rider combination
- If showing more than 2 different tests (Traditional Dressage) with same horse and rider combination, the 2 highest scores will count towards High Point Rider Award.
- Each division will be place by test ridden and awarded a rosette ribbon from 1st to 6th place. Junior and Adult Amateur Division will be placed together. **Junior and AA divisions will be placed separately if there are 5 or more Juniors or AA showing in the same test.**
- A High Point and Reserve High Point Rider will be selected per division (must be same horse and rider combination)
- Divisions are Child (under 12), Junior (13 to 17), Adult Amateur (18 and up), Open (all ages and/or professionals).
- High Point Awards will be announced at end of each day.

- Here are the Class Groups offered per division:

- Combine score 2 classes with same horse and rider combination in the same Class Group.
- If showing more than 2 classes in the same Class Group with same horse and rider combination, the 2 highest points will count towards High Point Rider Award.
- Each division will be place by height and awarded a rosette ribbon from 1st to 6th place. Junior and Adult Amateur Division will be places together in each height class. **Junior and AA divisions will be placed separately if there are 5 or more Juniors or AA showing at the same class.** Awards per height per division will be announced at the end of each class. **If a rider is competing alone in a division, no points will be awards to the series and may not qualify for High Point on Jumper day; they may receive a ribbon for participation.**
- A High Point and Reserve High Point Rider will be selected per division (must be same horse and rider combination)
- Divisions are Child (under 12), Junior (13 to 17), Adult Amateur (18 and up), Open (all ages and/or professionals)
- High Point Awards will be announced at end of each day.

Grand Champion Award

- Qualifying divisions are Child (under 12), Junior (13 to 17), and Adult Amateur (18 and up)
- Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion will be selected per division for same rider and horse combination with highest combined Dressage and Jump Days points.
- Awards will be announced on Sunday after the last class.

Year End Awards

Kahalawai Show Series year starts in February and ends in December.

Same rider/horse combination points will start at first showing during any Kahalawai Show Series year. Accumulative Point will be listed in the Kahalawai Show Series Program.

Same rider/horse combination will be required to reach a certain amount of points during a two year period to level out of dressage level and/or jumper height level.

If same rider/horse combo doesn't reach set points in 2 years, points from the most recent two years will be counted. For example, rider/horse combo gets 20 points their first year and 40 points their second year. They do not have enough points to level up. However, if they collect 60 points their third year, those points will combine with their second year points to put them at 100 points. This will allow them to show in the Kahalawai Show Series at the next highest level. Points will go back to Zero when starting a new level.

Points required to level up:

- Dressage: same rider/horse combo must reach total points of 40 points within 2 years
- Jumpers: same rider/horse combo must reach total point of 80 points within 2 years

The Kahalawai Show Committee will inform riders and trainers of their up to date points thru out the year. Individuals will be able to review results at the Kahalawai Website at www.LahainaRidingLessons.com

Year End High Point Awards:

Awarded to the same rider/horse combination with total highest points during one Kahalawai Show Series Year.

- Dressage Champion by level by division 1st level and up
- Jumper Champion by height by division (2'0" and up)
- Combined Champion (Dressage - 1st and up - and jumper-0.60m or 2'0" and up)

Kahalawai Show Series Championship Show Qualifications

Championship Show will take place the following year. Location, Date and Qualifying Riders will be announced at our Year End Banquet. Status can be checked at Kahalawai Website (www.LahainaRidingLessons.com)

All same rider/horse combination must collect during the same year in:

- Dressage 1st to 4th level 24 points (Open division - all divisions compete together)
- Jumper 0.60m or 2'0" and up 50 points (Open division - all divisions compete together)
